

Important Tips for Use

- This device uses a capacitive touch screen, do not use sharp object to touch the screen. Do not clean it with abrasive cleaning solutions, such as alcohol.
- Keep out of high temperatures, high humidity, and dusty environments.
- Do not disconnect the device while formatting data as this may damage or erase your device memory.

Controls and Functions



- 1. Power:** After plugging in the power adapter for the first time, the unit will power on automatically. Quickly press the power button toggle the screen on/off while the unit remains powered on. Press and hold the power button for three seconds to turn off the unit. **Note: Do not unplug the power adapter without turning off the device.**
- 2. Reset:** Use a needle, paper clip, or small tool to press the button inside the hole to reset the frame.
- 3. Micro USB:** Use an OTG cable (not included) to connect the frame to a USB drive or computer. You can import photos from the USB drive or computer onto the frame but cannot copy photos from the frame onto the USB drive. The frame cannot playback photos via the USB drive directly. This port does not support charging external devices.
- 4. Micro SD Card Slot:** Use to import photos from a MicroSD card onto the frame, copy photos from the frame onto a MicroSD card, or playback from an inserted MicroSD card directly.
- 5. DC In Port:** Plug in the included AC/DC power adapter to power on the frame.
- 6. Stand Slot:** Insert the included stand attachment to set your frame on a table or other surface. Supports both portrait and landscape orientation.
- 7. Anti-Theft Lock Slot:** Slot to connect Anti-Theft Lock (not included).

Setup

Power

Plug in the power adapter to turn unit on. Keep power adapter in at all times when unit is powered on. Press and hold the power button to successfully power off the unit before removing the power adapter. You can power the screen on/off by quickly pressing the power button while the unit is still powered on.

Frameo Quick Setup

After powering up your frame for the first time, an electronic Quick Start Guide will appear to detail the basic setup steps.

Next, you will need to set up the frame on the Frameo app. For best results, make sure to update your Frameo app when a new version becomes available.

1. Select a user language for the Frameo app.
2. Connect to your Wifi network.
3. Enter your name and the location of your frame (e.g., "Living Room" or "Hallway").

Note: After initial setup, you can change the settings any time through the settings menu. During setup, update the software to the most recent version if prompted.

Download the Frameo App

To send photos from your phone directly to your frame, download the Frameo app for iOS or Android. You can find the Frameo app on Google Play or the App Store.



Connecting to Wi-Fi

Connect to Wi-Fi to begin receiving photos to your frame.

1. Tap the screen to bring up the main menu.
2. Tap the Wi-Fi icon on the side panel
3. Select your Wi-Fi network from the list. To enter network access credentials, if applicable, press the  button.

Connect Using the Frameo App

When adding friends to a frame, they must receive the code for the frame similarly to setting up the frame and Frameo app.


- Open the Frameo app. Tap the  icon on the top left corner of the frameo menu.
- Enter the code from the frame and select Okay.

Frameo App Navigation

After powering up your frame for the first time, you will need to set up the frame on the Frameo app. For best results, make sure to update your Frameo app when a new version becomes available.



Menu

Access the menu by tapping on the screen.

- Add Friend: Generates a friend code to add others as users on the frame.
- Setting: Opens the settings menu.
- Power: Opens the power menu.
- Reactions: Opens the react menu.
- Hide Photo: Hides the current photo in the slideshow. You can unhide a hidden photo through the settings menu.
- Gallery: Opens the photo gallery stored on the frame.
- Fit to Frame/Fill Frame: Toggles how the photo is shown, either scaled to fit the whole screen centered on the important focus of the photo, or ensure the entire photo is shown on the screen
- Adjust Photo: Allows you to adjust the position of the current photo in the frame, including rotating the image, or edit captions.

Power Menu

Tap the button to open the power menu.

1. Press the button to power off your frame.
2. Press the button to restart the frame.
3. Press the button to enter sleep mode.

Interacting with Video

When videos play on the slideshow, two additional controls appear: a play/pause button to control playback, and a button for volume control.

1. Press the button to start video playback. Press the button to pause video playback.
2. Press the button to open the volume slide. Use the slider to adjust the volume level.
3. Press the button under the volume slider to mute video sound. Press the button again to unmute.

Uploading Photos

Uploading a Photo to a Frame from Your Phone

Upload photos directly from your phone to your frame through the Frameo app. **Note:** To upload photos, the Frameo app must have access to the photo app on your phone. You can change these access permissions through the settings app on your phone.

1. Open the Frameo app. The app should default to a gallery view of the photos on your phone.
2. Tap the photo you wish to upload. Tap "Next" in the upper right corner of the screen.
3. Select the frame you wish to upload the photo to. Tap "Next" to confirm.
4. (Optional) Write a caption that you would like to appear with the photo. Tap "Next" when finished or to skip.
5. Center the focus point of the photo (most important part of the photo) in the circle. Tap "Send Photo" when finished.

Photo Gallery

After powering up your frame for the first time, you will need to set up the frame on the Frameo app. For best results, make sure to update your Frameo app when a new version becomes available.


- Swipe left or right to navigate through your photo library.
- Tap the screen once to access the menu bar.

Uploading a Photo to a Frame from a MicroSD Card

You can upload photos directly to your frame from a MicroSD card. However, you cannot display photos directly from the MicroSD. You must first import the photos to the frame.

1. Insert a MicroSD card into the slot on the back of the frame.
2. The external storage menu will automatically appear on screen.
3. Tap the  button on the menu to import photos to the internal memory of the frame.

Note: Supports NTFS and FAT file types. Maximum MicroSD card size supported: 128GB.




Uploading Photos

Uploading a Photo to a Frame via MicroUSB

You can upload photos to the frame from a USB drive if you also use an OTG cable (not included).

1. Insert an OTG cable into the port on the back of the frame. Connect your USB device to the other end of the cable.
2. The external storage menu will automatically appear on screen.
3. Tap the  button on the menu to import photos to the internal memory of the frame.



Export Photos to a MicroSD card

You can save copies of photos uploaded to the frame on a MicroSD. Exporting copies of photos only works with a MicroSD card and will not transfer to any other external storage.

1. Insert a MicroSD card into the slot on the back of the frame.
2. The external storage menu will automatically appear on screen.
3. Tap "Backup."
4. The frame will automatically detect the MicroSD card. All photos on the frame will copy onto the MicroSD card.
5. If you keep the MicroSD card inserted into the frame, each export will only copy new photos that have not been exported to the card yet.

Frame Settings

Navigating your Frame


After powering up your frame for the first time, you will need to set up the frame on the Frameo app. For best results, make sure to update your Frameo app when a new version becomes available.

- Swipe left or right to navigate through your photo library.
- Tap the screen once to access the menu bar.

My Frame

Personalize your frame to suit your needs.

- **Frame Name:** Changes the name of your frame. This name is what connected friends and family will see in their list of connected frames.
- **Frame Location:** Changes the displayed location of your frame. This change will show up on connected family and friends' list of connected frames.
- **Set Language:** Allows you to change the display language within the frame.
- **Time Zone:** Select your time zone for display.



Frame Settings


Manage Photos

Make changes to your photo library.

- **Show/Hide Photos:** Select photos to show by tapping them in the gallery. Tap photos again to hide them. Hidden photos will appear in grayscale in the photo library but will not appear in the slideshow. Hidden photos will not be deleted and can always be reselected. Use the  button to select or deselect all.
- **Delete Photos:** Select the photos that you want to permanently delete from your frame. Use the  button to select or deselect all and the  button to delete the selected photos.
- **Import Photos:** Select to import photos to your frame from an external MicroSD card. Select the photos you want to import, then tap the  button to start the import process.

Tap the  button to select or deselect all photos on the external storage device.

- Tap the  to set the sort order of photos before importing. Tap the  button to sort the photos in ascending order.
Note: It is currently not possible to add a caption or define the most important part of the photo while using the import function.
- **Export photos:** Allows you to export photos from the frame to external storage. The export function will export all photos on the frame as well as profile pictures.
- **Playback from external storage:** Enables or disables playback of photos and videos directly from an external storage devices without taking up storage space on the frame. An external storage device must be inserted in the frame to enable this feature.
 - **Note:** After removing an external storage device, playback will automatically disable. You will need to enable playback again after reinserting an external storage device.



My Friends

Manage the list of people allowed to send photos to your frame.


- **Add Person:** Tap the  button and share your frame code to add a new friend to your friends list and allow them permission to send you photos.
- **Change options for a friend:** Click the options icon to open the friends options menu. From here, you can allow or remove permissions for a friend to share the code to the frame.
- **Remove Person:** Tap the delete friend button to remove a friend from your friends list and remove their permission to send you photos. Answer the prompts to confirm the removal. You can also remove all photos sent from this person.

Frame Settings

Display

Manage frame display options and operations.

- **Brightness Level:** Change the brightness of the display by sliding the adjustment bar.
- **Sleep Mode:** Set sleep mode start and stop times to reduce power consumption by turning off the screen. The default setting starts sleep mode at 11:00pm and stops at 7:00am. In analog view, tap times on the clock display or drag the hand on the clock. In digital view, type in the time using the pop-up keyboard.



Slideshow

Manage frame display options and operations.

- **Timer:** Define how long a photo is displayed on the frame.
- **Show Caption:** Display or hide photo captions.
- **Fill Frame:** Toggle on/off whether to display photos to fill the frame or maintain original dimensions.
- **Frame Background:** Set frame background when fill frame is off with blurred, black, or color gradient.
- **Photo display order:** Newest to oldest for upload date, newest to oldest for date taken, or shuffle.
- **Reverse photo display order:** oldest to newest for upload date or date taken.

The following settings under slideshow specifically apply to video display options and operations.

- **Autoplay:** Enables/disables video autoplay in the slideshow.
- **Video Playback:** Loop videos until slideshow timer ends, play once during slideshow then show its thumbnail afterward, video will play once and then continue to the next photo or video.
- **Auto mute:** Enable to automatically mute the video volume after a certain amount of time without interacting with the frame.
- **Video volume:** Adjust the volume level for video sounds on the frames.

Wi-Fi

Set which Wi-Fi network the frame connects to.

- **Wi-Fi details:** Tap the ⓘ icon to show details about the current connected Wi-Fi network.
- **Reset Wi-Fi:** Tap the ⋮ icon to delete stored Wi-Fi information and restart the frame.

Frame Settings

Notifications

Manage notification settings.

- **Show notifications:** Enables or disables whether notifications appear in the slideshow.
- **Notification volume:** Adjust the volume level for notification sounds.
- **Storage space:** Enables or disables notification alerts when frame storage is low.
- **Backup:** Enables or disables notification alerts when automatic backup has failed.
- **Network connection:** Enables or disables notifications showing network connection status.
- **New photos:** Enables or disables notifications when receiving new photos.
- **New friends:** Enables or disables notifications when new friends are added.
- **Software update:** Enables or disables notifications when a new software update has been installed.
- **Feature news:** Enables or disables notifications when new features are added.
- **Date and time:** Enables or disables notification alerts if time or date settings are incorrect.

Backup and Restore

- **Backup frame to external storage:** Tap to make a backup file of your photos, friends, and settings to a MicroSD card. Note: Existing backup data on the MicroSD card will be overridden.
- **Automatic Backup:** Set an automatic backup cycle that activates within 30 hours of receiving new photos or making changes on the frame. Requires a writeable MicroSD card inserted in the frame.
- **Reset Frame:** Removes all data from your frame, including photos, friends, and settings

When selecting "**Restore from Backup:**"

- First, confirm that the backup is up to date by checking the date under "Backup frame to external storage."
- If you wish to restore backup on a frame that is already set up, you must reset the frame. Resetting the frame will delete all data on the frame and reset the Frameo app to the setup screen.
- If the "Restore from backup" button isn't visible, confirm that the external storage is correctly mounted to the frame.

Help

- **Open source libraries:** Opens a list of open source libraries used in the app and their licenses.
- **Share anonymous analytics data:** Choose whether or not you wish to share your analytics data to developers to review for future updates.
- **Guide:** Review the electronic Quick Start Guide that automatically launched when you first powered on your frame.
